- The international tiebreaker rule will be used at the top of the 8th inning or at the top of any inning once the 90- minute time limit has expired. There will be no tie games.
- All GHSA rules and run rules will apply.
- The 2 upper baseball fields can be used for warm ups if needed.
- In case of inclement weather we may alter the tournament format to get as many games in as possible.
